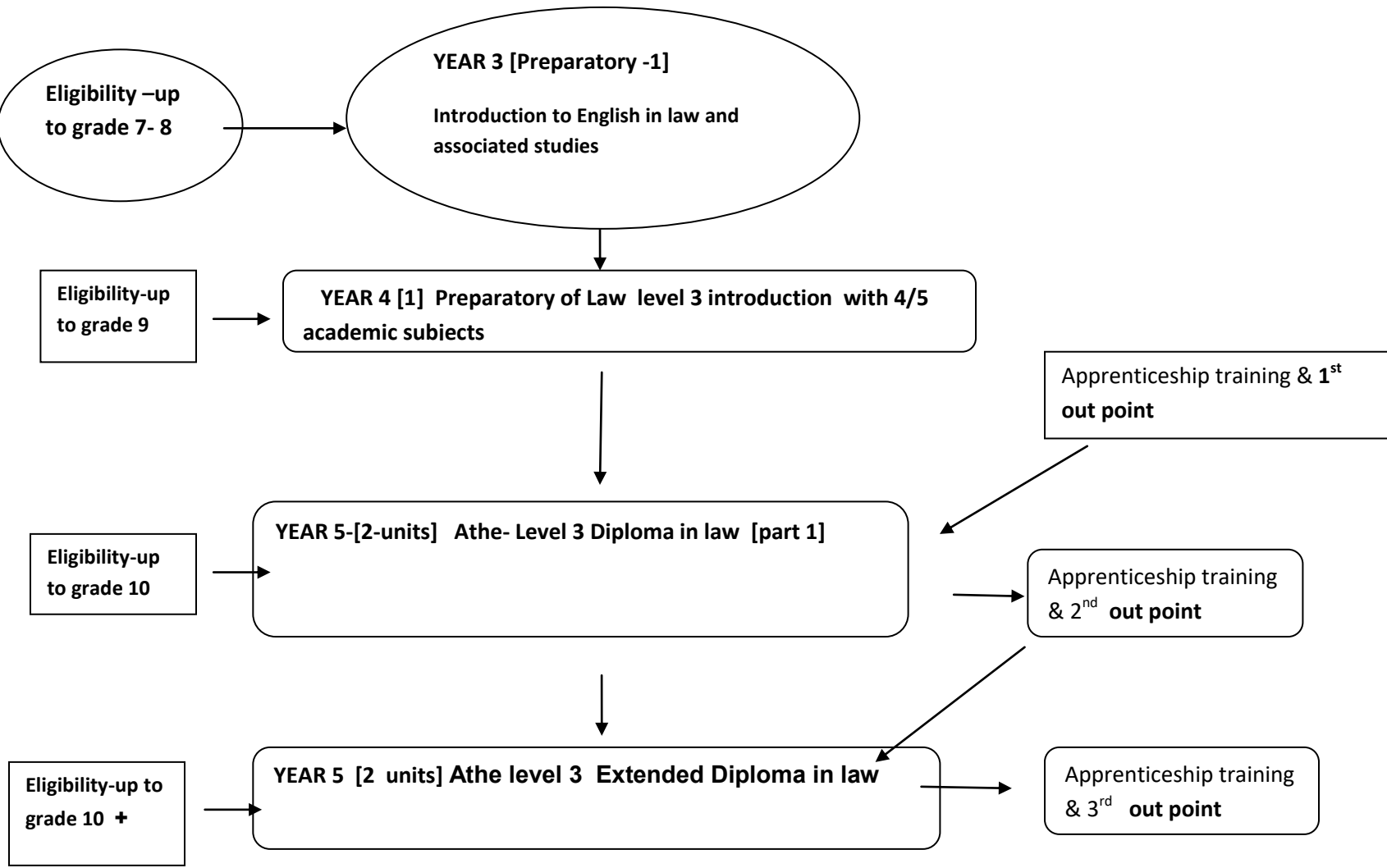

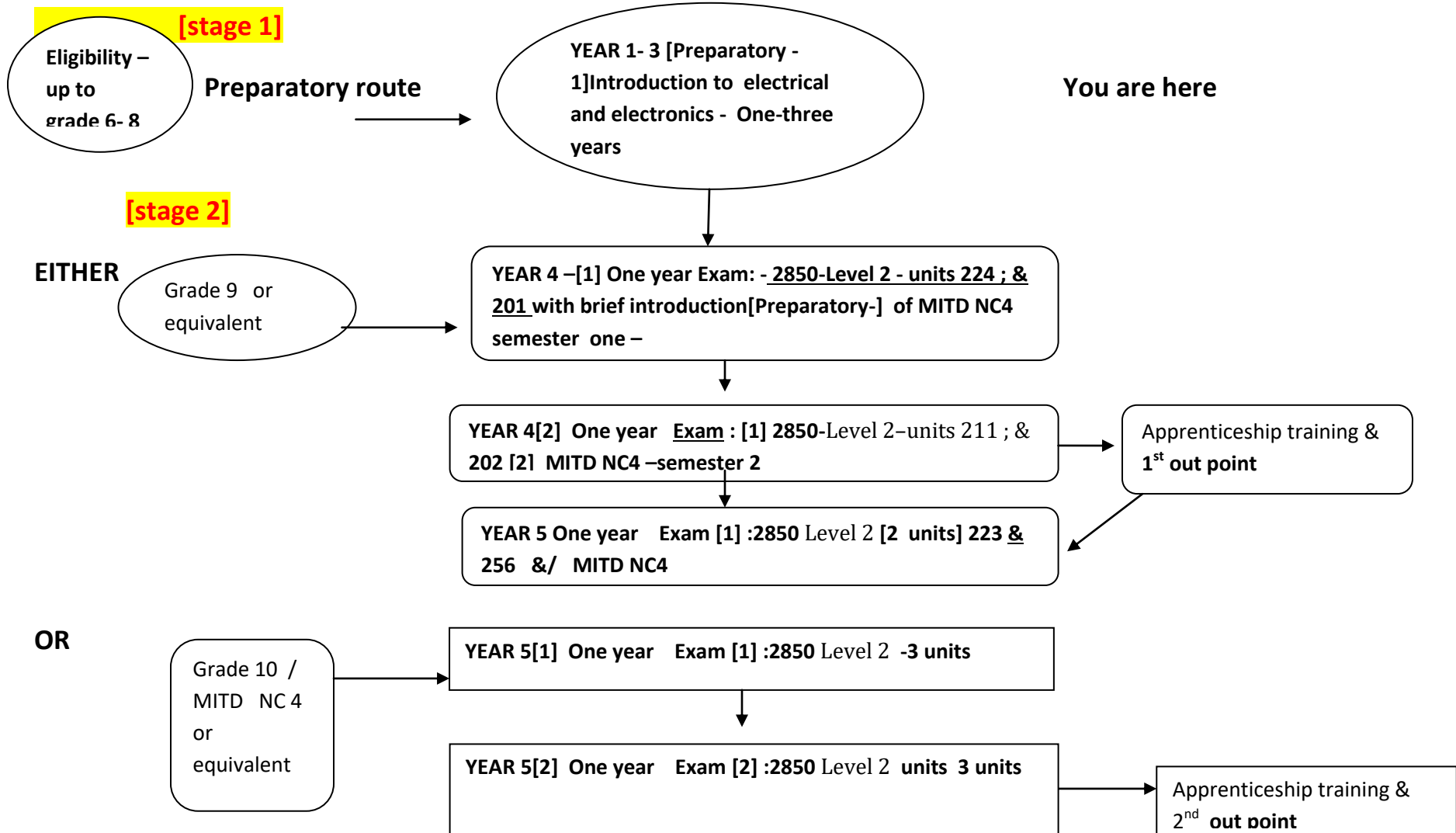


1[b] Law route

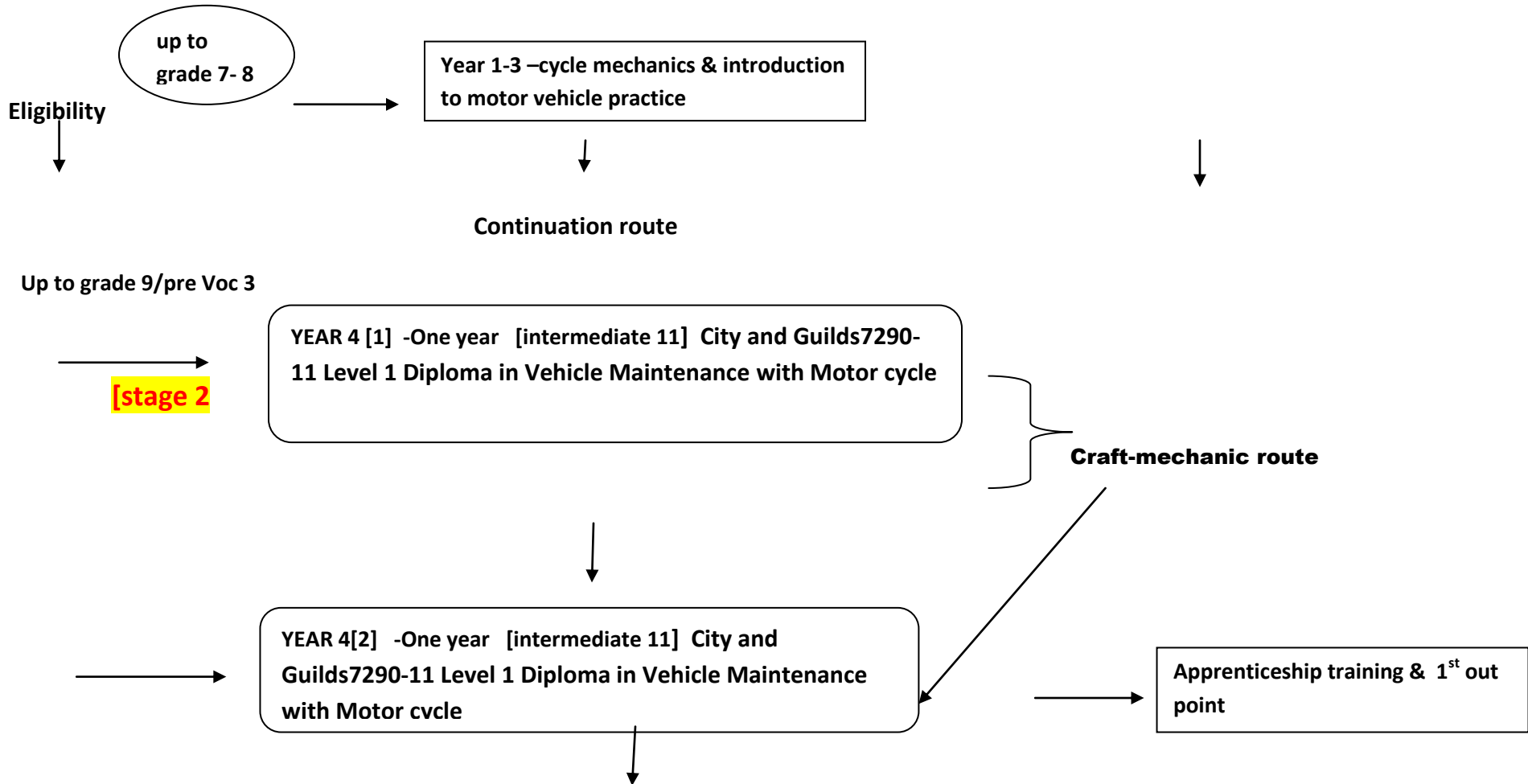

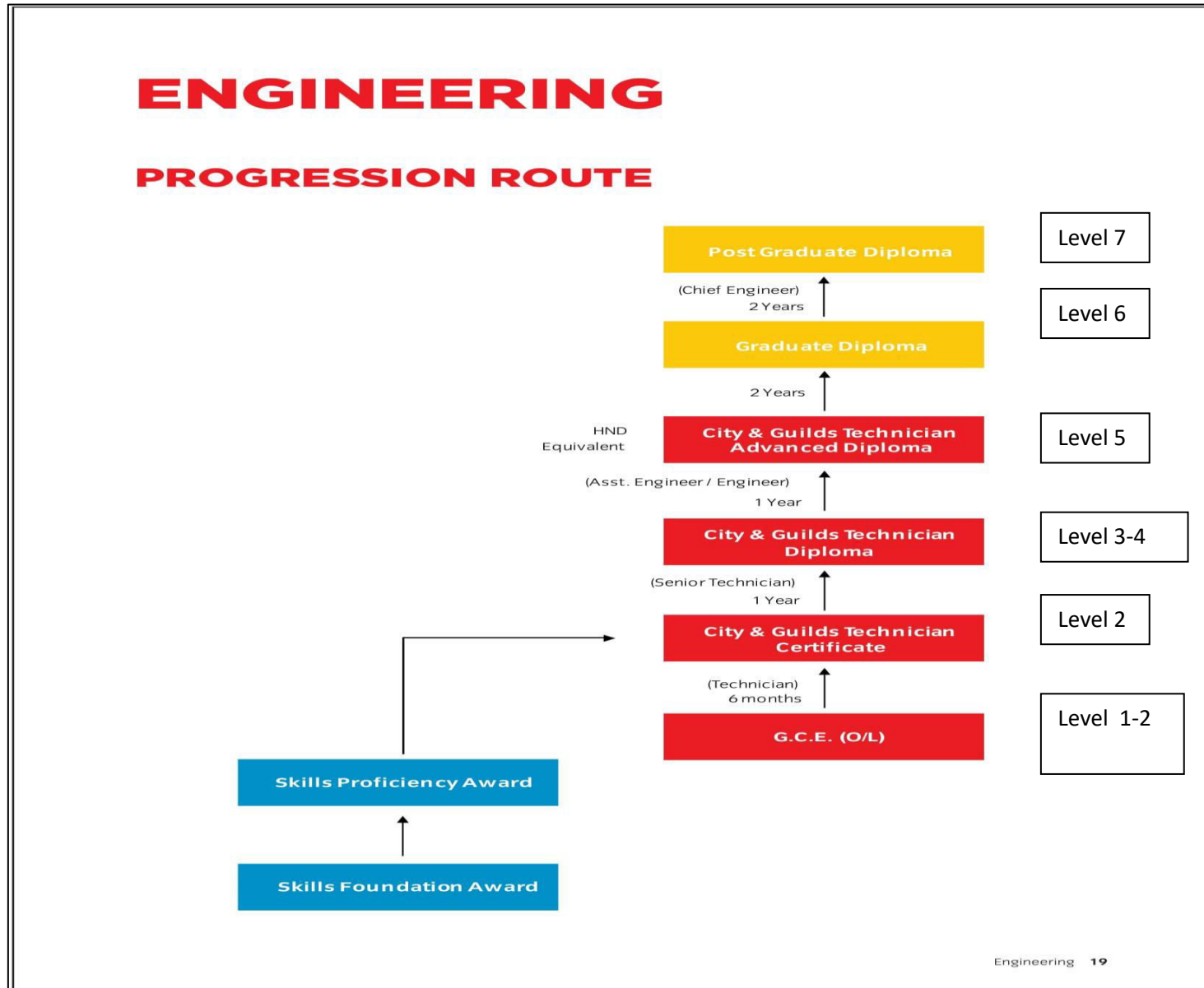
